

Point Leo SLSC Inc Nippers Competition Information

The Point Leo SLSC Junior Surf Lifesaving Program (**JSLP**), runs for children from the ages of 6 to 13 years as at 30th September. The following table shows the events for nippers of various ages and includes both individual and team events. These events incorporate a number of disciplines, which may also begin to teach the basics in rescue techniques, such as the board rescue event. Please note competition events are not held for Nippers in the Under 7 age group.

Not all events are held at each carnival. Programs will be available for each carnival during the JSLP program.

Note - U8s do not compete in the State Championships. U7s do not compete in Regional Championships.

S Badge Proficiency Test

All competitors must be designated as either “training” or “competing” swimmers for carnivals. Competitors not displaying an “S Badge” Proficiency patch as per the rules and regulations of SLSA **will not be permitted to compete.**

Competing Swimmers: May compete in all events

Training Swimmers: May compete in all beach and wade events

Officials Requirements - LSV requires clubs to supply officials at each carnival based on a ratio of **1 Water Safety Officer for every 10 Competitors and 1 Beach Official for every 20 Competitors within each of the age groups entered.**

Carnival uniforms

Requirements for Juniors are a club competition cap (compulsory), and bathers in club colours wherever possible.

Note: These are a minimum requirement but we encourage members to purchase the full uniform including a rash vest for sun protection. The uniform for all ages is available through the club at reasonable cost. Club uniform also identifies club members on the beach and at training.

Costs

The club is charged for each competitor who enters to compete at carnivals. A season fee is payable at the commencement of the season, along with membership fees, and covers Junior LSV carnival entries. Refer to the Fee Schedule on the download page for this year's fee.

Entries

Carnival entry lists with names of nippers who have paid competition fees will be available at the Sunday training session prior to the carnival date. All members must confirm their entry by the end of the training session so that they can be submitted to LSV by the due date. Club entries must be made on time as late entries incur a late entry fee of double the normal fee as well as the entry fee for each late entry. If a member does not confirm their entry prior to the entry due date, their entry will not be submitted. Should they then decide to participate they will be liable for payment of the late entry fee prior to participating in any events at the relevant carnival.
